The **Alaska Angel Conference** is a three-month program that brings together new investors and Alaska's most promising entrepreneurs to grow the state's innovation economy. Through hands-on education, mentorship, and real investment, the Conference helps build the next generation of investors while accelerating the success of Alaska startups.

For entrepreneurs, the Conference provides a unique opportunity to pitch to a group of active investors, refine communication skills, and compete for an equity investment of up to **\$100,000**, depending on the number of participating investors.

For investors, it offers a guided path into angel investing. Participants learn directly from experienced investors, collaborate throughout the due diligence process, and ultimately make a real investment decision as a group. What makes angel investing in Alaska unique is that, under Alaska's intrastate crowdfunding laws, Alaska residents can invest in Alaska companies regardless of accredited investor status—creating broader opportunities for community participation in startup investment and local economic growth.

By connecting investors and entrepreneurs, the Alaska Angel Conference strengthens Alaska's entrepreneurial ecosystem and helps launch the companies and leaders that will drive our state's future economy. Alaska's approach to investment helps democratize access to capital, allowing more Alaskans to directly support businesses they believe in while keeping investment dollars circulating within the state's economy.
